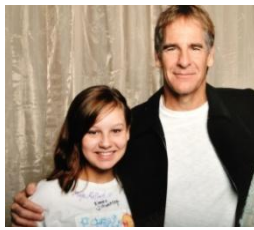

Primary Perspectives nominated for 4 CBAA Awards!

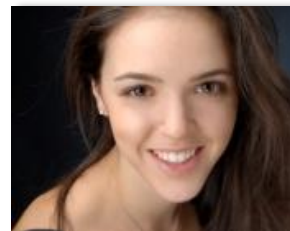
