Student Xpress - edition rundown

An eight-part series produced at 3ZZZ, and available through the Community Radio Network.All edition durations 27'50 minutes.

1. Arrival

International students' first experiences in Australia. We talk to a student who arrived in Australia when she was 18. She was badly treated by her student accommodation reception on her first day. She wasn't the only student we spoke to her cried soon after arriving in Australia.

2. Housing

International students' experiences finding somewhere to live in Australia. This program features a Chilean student who won a prize of a six month trip to Australia. All the students in this program said Australia was expensive.

3. Making Friends

The team speaks to six people about making friends. At first they made friends with their language group or their cultural group. Not drinking was often a barrier to forming Australian friendships. Most said their life here improved when they started to make friends with Australians.

5. Discrimination

6. Education Experiences
